

## WBMS Summer Camp - 2010

Summer camp will run Monday through Thursday, 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. with before and after care available. The children are provided with a morning snack, each child is to bring their own lunch daily.

### **Week 1: June 14-17th ~ Spanish Culture**

Come and learn about Spanish Culture with Angie Jones. WBMS Spanish Teacher will be here all week working with the children. The children will learn basic vocabulary: colors, numbers, seasons, weather and animals. The children will also experience Spanish food, games and songs.

### **Week 2: June 21-24th ~ The Art of Medieval Times**

Come ready to explore and create with artist Cassandra Monson! Travel back in time to Europe's Middle Ages and explore their art, their castles and fun children's games! Learn how to make simple mosaics and bind your own book! You will also learn all about medieval castles and build a mini castle!

### **Week 3: June 28 - July 1st ~ Travel to Mexico & Spain**

Come and learn about Spanish Culture with Angie Jones. They will travel to Mexico and Spain. While traveling to Mexico the children will learn to dance the Mexican hot dance, make and decorate a paper piñata, and make fresh corn tortillas and tacos. In Spain they will listen and dance to Flamenco music, make a red carnation flower made of paper and a paper hand fan.

### **Week 4: July 5-8th ~ Music with Patty Shade**

The children will explore the world via their bodies and voices. We will use the outdoor environment as our stage for our expression. At the end of this week the children will participate in a group play, from acting to stage support.

### **Week 5: July 12-15th ~ Science In Your Backyard**

Mad Science of MN will be at WBMS and together the children will get a hands on look at how things grow. They will learn a different part of the garden each day. The children will have the opportunity to perform a different experiment each day as well as play some games related to the day's topic.

### **Week 6: July 19-22nd ~ Cooking with Anne**

Anne Thayer will be showing the children delicious treats all week. The children will make mini pizza's and a salad bar. They will learn how to make a healthy fruit pop, cook pancakes and other breakfast favorites. She saved the best for last...ice cream in a bag for the final day.
